To: ALL COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTIONS

Re: Results of 2010 Federal Census

SUMMARY

The Secretary of State's office has received the official results of the 2010 federal census. The purpose of this Advisory is to explain how those results may impact municipal corporations (cities and villages), city school district candidate petition signature requirements, and the redistricting of congressional and state legislative districts.

THE FEDERAL CENSUS

Pursuant to R.C. 703.06, on March 30, 2011, the Secretary of State issued proclamations declaring the population of all municipal corporations based on the official results of the 2010 federal census. As a result of the 2010 federal census, some municipal corporations are being reclassified (from city to village or from village to city¹). Classifications of municipalities become official on April 29, 2011 (thirty days after the Secretary of State issued the proclamations). When a city's classification is being returned to a village because of the census results, the city may conduct an enumeration. R.C.703.02. All questions regarding the process of enumeration should be directed to the city law director or the legislative authority of the city.

Accompanying this Advisory is: 1) a list of the population of each county, city, village, township, and school district in the state, and 2) a list of cities and villages that are changing classification.

MUNICIPALITY STATUS

Some provisions of this Advisory may not apply to a municipal corporation that has adopted a charter containing provisions that differ from Ohio law. Accordingly, candidates for municipal office in a chartered municipality should review the municipality's charter.

¹ A municipality with a population of five thousand or more is as a city, and a municipality with a population of five thousand or less is a village. R.C.703.01(A).

Type of Election to be Held

The change in a municipal corporation's status (from a village to a city or from a city to a village) should not affect the type of elections held in the municipal corporation (i.e., primary or nonpartisan election). R.C. 3513.01(B). If a municipal corporation's status is changing, candidates for municipal office should file for office in the same manner that they would have filed for office if the municipal corporation's status were not changing (i.e., declaration of candidacy or nominating petition).

Officers to be Elected

Officers of a village advancing to a city or of a city reducing to a village "shall continue in office until succeeded by the proper officers of the new municipal corporation at the regular municipal election * * *." R.C. 703.07. Accordingly, officers elected at the November 2011 election will be the officers of a city, if a village is advancing to a city, or the officers of a village, if a city is reducing to a village.

Office of Municipal Court Clerk

Except as otherwise provided in R.C. 1901.31, the clerk of a municipal court is an elected position if the population of the territory served by the court equals or exceeds 100,000; however, if the population of the territory served by the court is less than 100,000, the position is appointed. The 2010 census results may change a clerk's position from an appointed position to an elected position. If a board of elections has questions about a specific municipal court clerk position and whether the position is elected or appointed, it should consult with the court or its assigned elections counsel.

City Wards

The legislative authority of a city is responsible for subdividing the city into wards. R.C. 731.06. Questions about dividing a city into wards should be directed to the city law director or the legislative authority of the city.

CITY SCHOOL DISTRICTS

The number of valid signatures required for petitions filed by candidates for members of boards of education of city school districts is based upon the total population of the city school district. R.C. 3513.254. It is possible that the number of valid signatures required in 2011 may be different for a city school district in your county than it was in 2009. Please see the attached spreadsheet that reflects the population of all school districts in the state in order to determine the correct number of valid signatures required to be filed for a city school district in your county, if applicable.

REDISTRICTING

The General Assembly will realign the boundaries of the state's congressional districts to accommodate the number of districts apportioned to the state based upon our relative population standing in the results of the national census. Ohio will be losing two congressional districts. In 2012, we will elect congressional representatives from 16 districts. There is no constitutional or statutory deadline by which the General Assembly must act to draw new congressional districts.

The Apportionment Board (comprised of the Governor, the State Auditor, the Secretary of State, one member selected by both the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Senate President and one member selected by the minority leaders of the House of Representatives and the Senate) will realign the boundaries of the state's House of Representatives and Senate districts. The total number of members of the Ohio House of Representatives and Senate will not change as a result of this process. The Ohio Constitution does not permit the Apportionment Board to meet before August 1, but its work must be completed by October 5 of this year. Section 1, Article 11, Ohio Constitution.

We are working with the members of the General Assembly to provide them with accurate information about the impact that their redistricting decisions will have on the duties of county boards of elections (including operational timelines relative to the administration of the 2011 general election and preparations for the 2012 presidential primary election). We will provide you with additional information on these processes as it becomes available.
