

DIRECTIVE 2025-02 AMENDMENT

August 28, 2025

To: Cuyahoga County, Huron County, Lucas County, and Morrow County
Board Members, Directors, and Deputy Directors

Re: Amendment to Directive 2025-02: Data Collection, Notice, and Cancellation
Procedures for Completion of the 2021 General Voter Records Maintenance
Program and Past Due Cancellations

SUMMARY

This directive partially amends [Directive 2025-02](#) and instructs the boards that mailed confirmation notices after September 20, 2021, to cancel abandoned registrations as described below.

INSTRUCTIONS

Under Ohio law, registrations shall be canceled not later than 120 days after the four-year anniversary date in 2025 of the mailing of the 2021 Confirmation Notice.¹

Huron County and Morrow County mailed confirmation notices under [Directive 2021-19](#) on September 21, 2021. As such, **the Huron County and Morrow County boards shall cancel abandoned registrations on September 23, 2025**, pursuant to Section II of [Directive 2025-02](#).

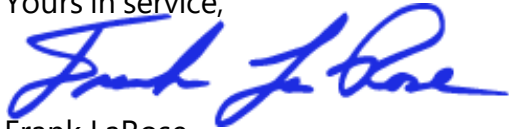
Lucas County mailed confirmation notices under [Directive 2021-19](#) on September 29, 2021. As such, **the Lucas County board shall cancel abandoned registrations on September 29, 2025**, pursuant to Section II of [Directive 2025-02](#). Additionally, **by noon on September 30, 2025**, the board shall upload the spreadsheet containing the registrations that received the registration readiness notice and were canceled.

Cuyahoga County mailed confirmation notices under [Directive 2021-19](#) on September 30, 2021. As such, **the Cuyahoga County board shall cancel abandoned registrations on October 1, 2025**, pursuant to Section II of [Directive 2025-02](#). Additionally, **by noon on October 2, 2025**, the board shall upload the spreadsheet containing the registrations that received the registration readiness notice and were canceled.
