Re: Mandatory Review of Directives Prior to Election Day

SUMMARY

This Directive requires all county board of elections Members, Directors, Deputy Directors and Staff to re-read important Directives prior to the March 15, 2016 Primary Election. While all instructions issued by my office are important, focusing on the Directives listed below will best prepare you to execute your statutory duties in the coming days and weeks.

INSTRUCTIONS

Every Member of a county board of elections, every Director, Deputy Director and relevant Staff must re-read each of the following Directives no later than Sunday, March 12, 2016:
