

Expedited Special Congressional Election Calendar
June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election Day
Election for the U.S. Representative, 6th Ohio Congressional District

March 18	Nominating petitions of independent candidates filed by 4 p.m. (day before primary election)
April 9	Form of official ballot for June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Elections must be certified by Secretary of State to boards (63 days before special general election)
April 26	Boards of elections must prepare and publish notice of the June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election by this date and provide the notice to federal write-in absentee voters upon request (46 days before special general election) UOCAVA absentee ballots for June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election must be ready (46 days before special general election)
April 30	Boards must advertise in newspapers the places, times, qualifications, and methods for voter registration. (6 weeks before special general election)
May 13*	Deadline for Voter Registration for June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (30 days before special general election)
May 14	Non-UOCAVA absentee ballots for June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (first day after close of registration) Early in-person voting begins (first day after close of registration)
May 28	Boards must prepare precinct voter registration lists for June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (14 days before special general election)
May 31	Deadline for political parties and groups of candidates to file observer appointments with the boards of elections (11 days before special general election)
June 1	Boards must give public notice of the June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (10 days before special general election)
June 4	Applications for absentee ballots to be mailed for the June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (7 days before special general election)

June 11 Special Congressional General Election

*Asterisk indicates that the statutory deadline falls on a day that boards of elections are closed, which means the deadline is extended to the next succeeding day the board of elections are open, pursuant to R.C. 1.14.

- June 15 Absentee ballots returned by U.S. Mail must be postmarked no later than June 10 and received by boards of elections by this date to be counted (4 days after special general election)
- UOCAVA absentee ballots must be received by boards of elections by this date to be counted (4 days after special general election)
- June 16 Boards of elections may begin the official canvass of the June 11, 2024 Special General Election (5 days after special general election)
- June 26 Boards of elections must begin the official canvass of the June 11, 2024 Special General Election (15 days after special general election)
- July 2 Boards of elections must complete the official canvass of the June 11, 2024 Special General Election (21 days after special general election)
- July 8* Deadline to request a recount of the June 11, 2024 Special Congressional General Election (5 days after certification of special general election results)
