

Expedited Special Congressional Election Calendar
March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election Day

Nomination and Election for the U.S. Representative, 6th Ohio Congressional District

- January 5 Once Governor DeWine issues the writ of election, Washington, Noble, Monroe, Belmont, Harrison, Jefferson, Carroll, Tuscarawas, Stark, Columbiana, and Mahoning County Boards of Elections must prepare and publish notice of March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election and provide notice to federal write-in absentee voters upon request (74 days before special primary election)
- January 19 Declaration of candidacy for partisan candidates must be filed with the Mahoning County Board of Elections by 4 p.m. (60 days before special primary election)
- Declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate for the March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election must be filed with the Mahoning County Board of Elections by 4 p.m. (60 days before special primary election)
- January 24 Mahoning County Board of Elections must certify names of candidates for March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election to Washington, Noble, Monroe, Belmont, Harrison, Jefferson, Carroll, Tuscarawas, Stark, and Columbiana County Board of Elections (55 days before special primary election)
- January 26 Protests against partisan candidacies must be filed with the Mahoning County Board of Elections by 4 p.m. (53 days before special primary election)
- Protests against write-in candidates must be filed with the Mahoning County Board of Elections by 4 p.m. (53 days before the special primary election)
- February 2 Boards of elections must prepare and publish notice of the March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election by this date and provide the notice to federal write-in absentee voters upon request (46 days before special primary election)
- UOCAVA absentee ballots for March 19, 2024 Special Congressional Primary Election must be ready (46 days before special primary election)
