WRIT OF ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 1, Section 2 of the United States Constitution and Ohio Revised Code Section 3521.03, the Governor must issue a Writ of Election when a vacancy in the office of Representative to Congress occurs; and

WHEREAS, on January 2, 2024, I received a letter from Congressman Bill Johnson of the Sixth Congressional District of Ohio. This letter was notifying me that Congressman Johnson is resigning from office at the end of the day on January 21, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the letter of resignation constitutes sufficient information that there is a vacancy in the office of Representative to Congress in the Sixth Congressional District of Ohio as of the end of the day on January 21, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike DeWine, Governor of the State of Ohio, after consultation with the Office of the Secretary of State of Ohio and upon representations made by that office, I do hereby direct that the boards of elections in the Sixth Congressional District of Ohio hold a special election on June 11, 2024 to fill such vacancy, and direct that the boards of elections give proper notice of such election as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 3521.03. I further direct, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3513.32, that if a primary election is necessary before the special election is held, then the boards of elections in the Sixth Congressional District of Ohio hold the primary election on March 19, 2024.
