

VOTE **NO** ON ISSUE 2
Unelected, Unaccountable and Unacceptable

Vote no on Issue 2. It removes the right of Ohio voters to have a voice in determining state legislative and Congressional district lines and gives this authority to a new unelected bureaucratic commission.

UNLIMITED

- This large new government bureaucracy can demand unlimited tax dollars to operate.
- Commission members set their own salaries.
- The commission can hire a large permanent staff and dozens of expensive lawyers and political consultants.

Vote No on Issue 2. It forces taxpayers to give nearly UNLIMITED FUNDING to an UNELECTED and UNACCOUNTABLE commission.

UNACCOUNTABLE

- Commission members are unelected and unaccountable to Ohio taxpayers.
- **OHIO VOTERS HAVE NO VOICE** in the selection process.
- Ohioans and their elected representatives cannot remove commission members (even if they commit a felony) or repeal the commission's decisions.

UNCONSTITUTIONAL

- This amendment forces judges to make political decisions and undermines the Constitution.
- The nonpartisan Ohio State Bar Association opposes this amendment and appellate court judges have raised serious concerns.
- Should the amendment pass, its constitutionality will be fought in the courts **costing Ohio taxpayers millions of dollars.**
- Legal experts believe the amendment ignores the separation of government powers, inappropriately moving legislative appointment authority to the judiciary.

Vote No on Issue 2. Our judges must remain free of political influence.

UNTESTED & UNACCEPTABLE

- **This politically motivated amendment dangerously places a permanent, untested process into Ohio's Constitution.** It would be virtually impossible to repeal or change.
- Arbitrary rules unfairly disqualify millions of Ohioans from serving on the commission.
