CRAWFORD COUNTY

Proposed School Income Tax - Colonel Crawford Local School District **1,073** **1,071**

Shall an annual income tax of 1.25% be levied on the district, for cpt, beginning 1/1/2008, for current operating expenses?

CUYAHOGA COUNTY

Proposed Charter Amendment - Maple Heights City **683** **511**

Shall Article VII, Section 20(b) of the Charter of the city be amended to increase the resident income tax credit from 80% to 100%, & fix municipal income tax rate at 2-1/2%, beginning 3/1/2007, & provide that this credit & rate may only be changed by a vote of the electors amending the Charter, at a general, primary or special election?

HAMILTON COUNTY

Proposed Municipal Income Tax - Forest Park City **610** **335**

Shall the ordinance providing for a 1.5% levy on income for public safety & general fund purposes, with up to 1.5% credit for residents for residents for wages taxes elsewhere, be passed?

LICKING COUNTY

North Fork Local School District (Licking*, Knox) **1,374** **1,028**

Shall an annual income tax of 1% on the earned income of individuals residing in the district, be imposed for 3 years, beginning 1/1/2008, to provide for current expenses?

MONTGOMERY COUNTY

Proposed Recall Election (by petition) - Moraine City **109** **151**

Shall Thomas Watts be allowed to continue at Ward 3 Council Member?
