**ASHLAND COUNTY**

*Ashland City School District (Ashland\*, Richland) (Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 2,892 **3,613**

Shall the Ashland City School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct, add to, renovate, remodel, furnish, equip & otherwise improve school district buildings & facilities & acquire, clear, improve & equip their sites, in the principal amount of \$40,000,000 which amounts to 4.24 mills, for 37 years -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 0.5 mill, for cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate & finance general permanent improvements -

**DELAWARE COUNTY**

*Olentangy Local School District (Delaware\*, Franklin)(Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 9,643 8,461

Shall the Olentangy Local School District be authorize to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct, furnish & equip new school facilities, with related site improvements & appurtenances thereto; to renovate, repair, improve, furnish, equip & construct additions to existing school facilities, buildings & infrastructure; replace existing equipment & construct various permanent improvements; purchase school buses & related transportation equipment; curriculum implementation district-wide, including related textbooks & technology; to acquire land & interests in land, in the principal amount of \$24,400,000, which amounts to 0.5 mill, for 30 years, commencing in 2011, first due in calendar year 2012 -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 7.9 mills, for cpt, commencing in 2011, first due in 2012, for current operating expenses -

**HANCOCK COUNTY**

*Arlington Local School District (Misc. question and Bond Issue)* 754 **916**

Shall Arlington Local School district be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Impose an annual income tax of 0.5% of the school district for cpt, beginning 1/1/2012, to pay current operating expenses -  
 Issue bonds to construct school facilities & renovate existing school facilities under the Ohio School
- 2) Facilities Commission Classroom Facilities Assistance program; to furnish & equip the same & improve the sites in the principal amount of \$7,301,094, which amounts to 5.5 mills, for 37 years -

**HARDIN COUNTY**

*Kenton City School District (Hardin\*, Wyandot) (Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 934 **1,235**

Shall the Kenton City School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct school facilities under the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program of the Ohio School Facilities Commission & locally funded initiatives; to furnish & equip the same & improve the sites thereof, in the principal amount of \$13,700,000, which amounts to 4.29 mills, for 28 years -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 0.5 mill, for a cpt, to provide for the acquisition, construction, enlargement, renovation & financing of permanent improvements -

*Ridgemont Local School District (Hardin\*, Logan) (Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 488 **506**

Shall the Ridgemont Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct school facilities under the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program of the Ohio School Facilities Commission & locally funded initiatives; to furnish & equip the same & improve the sites thereof, in the principal amount of \$7,169,896, which amounts to 6.17 mills, for 38 years -
- 2) Levy an additional tax of 0.5 mill, for cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate & finance permanent improvements -

**HURON COUNTY**

*Willard City School District (Huron\*, Crawford) (Misc. question & Tax Levy)* 1,254      972

Shall Willard City School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Impose an annual income tax of 3/4% on the earned income of the individuals residing in the school district, for a cpt, beginning 1/1/2012, to pay current operating expenses?
- 2) Issue bonds to construct school facilities under the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program & related facilities; renovate & improve existing facilities; furnish & equip the same; improve the sites thereof & acquire land & interests in land in the principal amount of \$10,500,000, which amounts to 3 mills, for 23 years -

**LORAIN COUNTY**

*Amherst Exempted Village School District (Bond Issue & 2 Tax Levies)* 2,674      3,562

Shall the Amherst Exempted Village School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct, furnish & equip a new elementary school & construct, add to, renovate, remodel, furnish, equip & otherwise improve school district buildings & facilities, including school district recreational facilities & to acquire, clear, improve & equip their sites in the principal amount of \$26,000,000, which amounts to 2.3 mills, for 37 years -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 0.5 mill, for a cpt, to provide for the acquisition, construction, enlargement, renovation & financing of general permanent improvements -
- 3) Levy an additional property tax of 3.95 mills, for 5 years, for current operating expenses -

**STARK COUNTY**

*Lake Local School District (Stark\*, Portage)(Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 2,485      2,652

Shall the Lake Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct, add to, renovate, remodel, furnish, equip & otherwise improve school district buildings & facilities & to acquire, improve & equip real estate for school purposes in the principal amount of \$12,282,943, which is 1.8 mills, for 28 years, commencing in 2011, first due in calendar year 2012 -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 0.5 mill, for a cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate & finance general permanent improvements -

**WASHINGTON COUNTY**

*Warren Local School District (Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 3,049      3,057

Shall the Warren Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct school facilities & locally funded initiatives under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program of the Ohio School Facilities Commission; to furnish & equip the same; improve their sites thereof; & acquire land & interests in land as necessary, in the principal amount of \$31,820,000, which amounts to 8.19 mills, for 28 years -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 0.5 mill, for a cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate & finance permanent improvements -

**WAYNE COUNTY**

*Dalton Local School District (Bond Issue & Tax Levy)* 1,141      829

Shall the Dalton Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds to construct, renovate, remodel, rehabilitate, add to, furnish, equip & otherwise improve school district buildings & facilities & acquire, clear & improve real estate for school district purposes in the principal amount of \$14,750,000, which amounts to 6 mills, for 28 years -
- 2) Levy an additional 0.5 mill, for a cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate, & finance general permanent improvements -

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
