Help Us Count Your Ballot

When you returned your ballot, some of the required information was missing or incorrect. Because of this missing or incorrect information, your county board of elections cannot count your ballot. You can fix the problem and have your vote counted. The reason your ballot cannot be counted is shown in the form below.

Provide the missing information and return this form to your county elections office. You can:

- Deliver the completed form at the county board of elections office by the 7th day after the election.
- Mail the completed form so it is postmarked by the 7th day after the election and received at the board of election by the 10th day after the election.

All of the reasons your ballot cannot be counted are checked.

Please read this section carefully and provide the missing information.
